



Delicate, finished distributor shafts are stored, flow metered, elevated and released to an assembly machine.

Similar to a toothpick dipenser, the rod feeder bin is manually loaded with any one of the three part lengths to flow out a single stub track.

Equipped with special lift cleats and a pneumatic indexing drive, the elevating conveyor takes one part at a time from the rod feeder track for final release to an overhead chute.

Elevator cover guards are shown removed for a better view.

Gentle handling and quiet performance are the main features of this simple but reliable feeder system.
